

LAKE OKEECHOBEE HYDROLOGIC PERFORMANCE MEASURES
1965-2000 Simulation Period

Number of times lake stage is above 17.25 ft for more than 7 days:

07LORS	6
alt1aS2	2
albS2-A	1
a2a-A	0
a4-A	0

Number of days lake stage is below 12.56ft:

07LORS	2557
alt1aS2	4532
albS2-A	4809
a2a-A	5229
a4-A	4841

Notes:

It is necessary to review the lake stage hydrograph to ensure that double counting has not taken place. For example, if the lake stage goes above 17.25 ft for a day and subsequently falls below 17.25 ft the next day, the number of events counted will be two; whereas, by looking at the lake stage hydrograph, one can make the determination that it should only be counted as a single event.
